Case Summary;

A Super Villain known as Slyde has robbed 12 banks in Southern Idaho since February 2003.

The first Robbery was in February 2003 and the subsequent robberies have been space unevenly since that time. No apparent pattern can be detected in the crimes. Each job nets between \$25,000 and \$35,000 USD.

It is believed the targets have been chosen due to the lack of high-threat response in the area. The targets have all been hit during business hours, always on weekdays never on weekends. The robberies are always single jobs, never a spree. Slyde never speaks during his jobs so no useful voice information is available to aid in identification.

Forensic evidence on the scene and eyewitness accounts at all crime scenes has established Slyde as the sole perpetrator of these crimes.

Available forensic evidence includes samples of a high quality friction reducing lubricant found at the scene of each crime.
